Diabetic Dilated Eye Exams

A dilated eye exam may detect eye disease before noticeable vision loss occurs. When diabetic retinopathy is detected early, treatment is 95% effective in preventing severe vision loss. Controlling diabetes may help slow the progression of diabetic retinopathy.

Below you will find a list of optometrists and ophthalmologists who can perform a dilated eye exam once a year, or as recommended. <u>Please inform the office of your diabetes diagnosis when</u> scheduling the appointment and completing any registration/clinical information forms.
